CINNABAR FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES 2013 GRANT PROGRAM

The Cinnabar Foundation is now accepting applications for our annual competitive grant program at ConserveMontana.org. This website, launched in June 2012, serves as an interactive atlas for conservation stories of all types across Montana and the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. As of January 1, 2013, more than 340 conservation stories have been submitted by Cinnabar grant applicants as well as individuals, families, volunteers, students, civic groups, businesses and others.

The grant application form is in two parts, one private and one public. Grant requests and proposal summaries will be seen only by the staff and board of directors at the Cinnabar Foundation. Applicants for general operating or special project grants are asked to share their organizational and personal stories with the public as part of their application. The foundation will consider both your private application and your group's public stories in our grant-making process.
