The Cinnabar board established the Jim Posewitz Professional Conservationist Award, in 2016, to honor the Foundation's first executive director and a founding board member.

In 2018, the award was presented to **Alex Sienkiewicz** for holding standing tall in defense of the principles and idealism at the core of the U.S. Forest Service and helping to create precedent with national implications — historic public access is legal and it matters. Five organizations were chosen to honor Alex and shared equally the \$5,000 award.
