RICK HUBBARD SARGENT INNOVATION AWARD DESIGNEE

\$10,000 – 1 Grant

The Rick Hubbard Sargent Innovation Award was established in 2012 to honor the Cinnabar Foundation's founders son and former board member upon his passing that year. The purpose of the award is to recognize conservation work that pushes boundaries with the intent to expand understanding about more sustainable ways of being in relationship with our natural world. Specifically, this award pays tribute to innovative applications of new knowledge or new approaches on conservation, ecology and environmental issues that have the potential to radically change prevailing practices and transform existing paradigms.

The first RHS Innovation Award was made to the Montana Watershed Coordination Council for its innovative approach to combining state, federal and foundation funding in a statewide "Watershed Fund" to advance two primary goals:

- 1) Increase the capacity of local communities to advance community-based and locally led conservation, and
- 2) Provide a model for streamlining, consolidating, and leveraging resources for locally led conservation statewide.

The Watershed Fund provides grant opportunities to more than 60 local watershed organizations throughout Montana, and will be used to assist with organizational capacity building, professional development opportunities for watershed coordinators, and project implementation. Supporting MWCC's Watershed Fund leverages Cinnabar's investment for greater impact statewide.

The purpose of the fellowship is to provide additional awards in the Institute's **Baucus Leaders Program** to recipients demonstrating a keen interest in public service and conservation values.
