2022 Conservation Partners - Final Tally

Thanks to the generosity of our annual donors and the far-sighted philanthropy of Legacy Society members, in 2022 Cinnabar awarded 65 grants and six awards totaling \$502,000. Our grantees leveraged this amount to over \$1million to directly support conservation in this region.

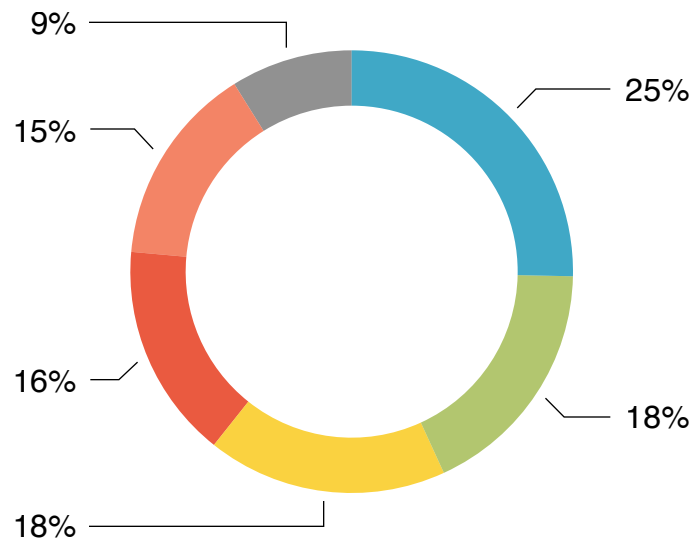
